



## ULYP COMMITTEES

ULGC-YP has several committees that are responsible for various activities that members can get directly involved in planning and executing. The standing committees of ULYP shall consist of (i) social and cultural development, (ii) economic empowerment and development, (iii) professional and personal development, (iv) civic and community engagement, (v) membership and outreach, (vi) and policies and procedures.

### **Social and Cultural Development**

The Social and Cultural Development committee shall help generate, plan, and execute all social and cultural activities aimed at the ULGC-YP membership. Events would consist of a signature ULYP social event, and potential documentary viewings, movie nights, and cultural forum for discussions. This group would consist of event coordinators who would be responsible for doing an event from start to finish under the guidance of the chairs.

### **Economic Empowerment & Development**

The Economic Empowerment and Development committee will develop partnerships and programs to promote the ability of Chattanoogaans to secure decent jobs, accumulate assets, and influence institutions and public policies determining growth and development. Activities may include collaborating with Community Development Financial Institutions that deliver responsible, affordable lending to help low-income, low-wealth, and other disadvantaged people and communities gain an access point into the economic mainstream.

### **Professional and Personal Development**

The Professional and Personal Development committee works in partnership with local businesses and corporations as well as Other Young Professional Organizations to deliver and provide opportunities for personal and professional development. Activities may include: Events that promote career advancement and professional development trainings; Events that promote enhanced economic opportunity, increased access to credit, financial literacy services that assist members and the community in acquiring or sustaining wealth; Career Networking opportunities.

### **Civic and Community Engagement**

The Civic & Community Outreach committee shall develop and coordinate community service events on behalf of the local chapter in which members address the economic, educational, cultural and health needs of individuals and families in the geographic area of support in which your local affiliate serves. It coordinates participation in all local affiliate community outreach events. The Civic & Community Outreach committee shall also keep an accurate account and log of the community service hours worked by members of the local chapter.

### **Policies and Procedures**

The Policies and Procedures committee helps chapter members to understand the basic purpose of parliamentary procedure. This committee advises the presiding officer and the members on parliamentary procedure; has reference materials on hand (Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised) pertaining to parliamentary procedure; observes progress of meetings and calls any significant irregularities to the attention of the chair ("point of..."); and prepared to explain any deviation from procedure and its effect on the rights of all members.

### **Membership and Outreach**

The Membership Committee shall be responsible for attracting, engaging and retaining new members to the organization. With the assistance of the Secretary and the Treasurer, the membership committee shall maintain the membership records, including accurate financial and communication records. It also hosts membership orientations and responsible for accurate and timely updates of the official membership database of chapter. This group will increase awareness of ULGC-YP with external professional, private and public organizations, as well as local universities and colleges for purposes of membership. This group works to identify and achieve outreach events and joint participation of external organizations with ULGC-YP to leverage a defined purpose or mission to everyone involved.
